

REQUIREMENTS

- > Bachelor degree in economics or related field with
- At least 10 ECTS in economics
- At least 10 ECTS in mathematics, statistics and / or econometrics
- At least 35 ECTS in both economics and mathematics, statistics and / or econometrics
- Adequate knowledge of English that can be demonstrated by e.g. an A level grade equivalent to B (good) or better, a stay of one year or longer in an English speaking country, or a TOEFL test with a score of 80 or higher in the internet based version.
- > Program starts in October (Winter term) and April (Summer term)
- > Application deadlines:
- For applicants from EU member states: July 15 (Winter term), January 15 (Summer term)
- For applicants from outside the EU: May 31 (Winter term),
 November 30 (Summer term)
