

## > APPLICATION AND ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Bachelor degree in economics or related field with

- At least 40 ECTS in economics
- At least 10 ECTS in mathematics, statistics and / or econometrics

Adequate knowledge of English that can be demonstrated by e.g. an A level grade equivalent to B (good) or better, a stay of one year or longer in an English speaking country, or a TOEFL test with a score of 83 or higher in the internet based version.

Program starts in October (Winter term) and April (Summer term)

Application deadlines:

- July 15 (Winter term),
- January 15 (Summer term)
