Internship:

- Exclusive internship for **one to two** students of the Finance Center Münster at the Asian Institute of Digital Finance of the National University of Singapore
- Participation in the Credit Research Initiative
 - **Non-Profit-Initiative** for Credit Ratings: Ratings as a Public Good
- **Minimum time period:** five to six month
- **Compensation** according to local standards
 - Salary comparable to an internship in Germany



Profile of requirements:

- **Preference** is given to participants of the excellence program *Finest in Finance*
 - Applications from other students at the Finance Center Münster are also welcome
- High degree of **intrinsic motivation**
- Quick **comprehension**



Tasks:

- Creation of own **credit ratings** using the latest scientific methods
 - Coverage of 133 different economies and more than 71,000 **publicly traded companies** across 12 sectors (e.g. tech, finance, oil & gas)
 - Publication of information accessible to the general public
- Consultation of major **international organizations** and various **central banks** in different aspects of (credit) risk management
- Economic analyses for the preparation of **credit letters** for small and medium sized enterprises (on a weekly/quarterly/annual basis)

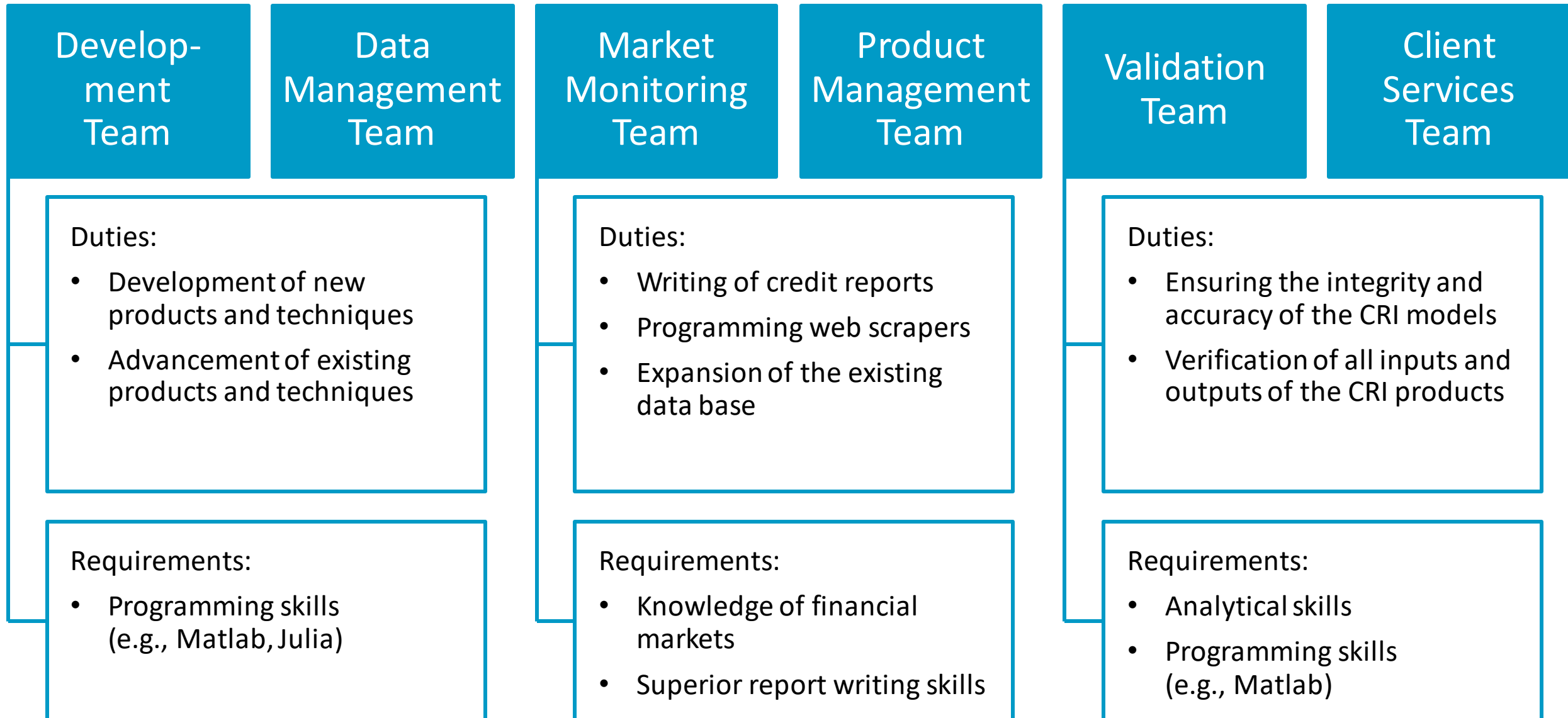

- Start time of the internship: annually at about the time of the academic **summer term**
 - Application documents should be sent to the Asian Institute of Digital Finance approximately **one year** before the desired start of the internship
 - Subsequent **online job interview**
