



The Chair of Political Economy at the School of Business and Economics at the University of Münster is seeking to fill the position of a

Full-time Post-Doctoral Researcher ("Akademische Rätin/Akademischer Rat auf Zeit"; Salary Level A 13)

from **June 1, 2023**. This fixed-term post is available for a 3-year period. Currently, the regular full employment time is 41 hours per week. The scope of duties includes the preparation and execution of research and teaching as well participation in administrative tasks. The teaching load is currently 4 hours per week for a full-time position.

The Chair is doing research in the fields of Political Economy/Public Choice, and is concerned in particular with the analysis of the relationship between political regimes and economic prosperity. This includes research on political decision-making processes in different political regimes, voter behavior in democracies and conflict patterns in autocracies.

A suitable candidate will have undergone a sound method-oriented training in economics or related social sciences and will hold a doctoral degree. Excellent knowledge in applied empirical methods and/or game theory is required as well as the willingness to conduct research within the scope of the Chair as outlined above.
